Present Real Conditional – OPEN	Present Unreal Conditional – HYPOTHETICAL
Zero conditional	Second conditional
If I <u>have</u> time, I <u>study</u> English.  Sometimes I have time.	If I <u>had</u> time, I <u>would study</u> English. <i>I don't have time</i> .
conditions which are always true	conditions which are impossible or improbable in the present or future
Past Real Conditional	Past Unreal Conditional
Second conditional  If I <u>had</u> time, I <u>studied</u> English.  Sometimes I had time.	Third conditional  If I had had time, I would have studied English.  I didn't have time.
Future Real Conditional	Future Unreal Conditional
First conditional  If I have time, I will study English.  If I have time, I am going to study English.  I don't know if I will have time or not.  Other forms possible.  conditions which are very probable in the future	Second conditional  If I had time, I would study English.  I won't have time.  Other forms possible.

Zero – IF + present, present/imperative

First – IF + present, future

Second – IF + past, would/could/might

Third – IF + past perfect, would+past participle (eg. have done)
